Entry is per vehicle day-trippers (£7) and overnight fees (£15.50 per vehicle per night), Tickets at www.vanjam.co.uk upon arrival to the rally field you will be directed to the show field or camping area. Day-trippers attending in modern cars will be asked to park in a separate section of the field as we will attempt to keep classic American vanners and other classics/trucks/vans together.

The rally field is where we are holding the event. The field is big enough for well over 100 vehicles. If camping we ask that you take the space you need but bear others in mind. The field has 2no 16amp power sockets for the Vanditos Marquee and Food Vendor. If campers would like to charge batteries, phones, IPad's a couple of 13amp sockets will be made available.

The rally field has rules imposed by the landowner. These rules are strict; failure to abide by the rules will result in all campers/vehicles being asked to leave. These rules include:

- Vanditos crew will be wearing a t-shirt showing the Vanditos Outlaw on the front and the VanJam 3 evil fingers on the back. Please follow directions given by the crew. Any questions or issues will be directed/sorted by Clive and Griff.
- No open fires. Barbeques and above ground fire pits can be used. The field has lush green grass; the owner doesn't want big round scorch marks.
- No loud noise after 11pm. The rally field is adjacent to a campsite; the noise restriction is imposed in consideration of our neighbours. We have a couple of DJ's who want to treat us with music. The music will stop at 11pm but we can still party on (quietly).
- The campsite showers/toilets are available for use. Please leave them as you find them. The shower/toilet block is down the hill (5 minutes away).
- Porta-loo's will be available just outside the field. These need to be accessible at all times so they can be emptied and cleaned.
 - Dogs are allowed but please ensure you clean up after them, please note all dogs need to be on a lead at all times (land owner rules).
 - Clean up after yourselves. Bins are available just outside the rally field.
 - Drinking water and wastewater disposal is available next to the bins.

As this is our second event we have decided to keep the event simple (same as last year). The aim is to get everyone together, admire classic vehicles, eat drink and be merry.

As mentioned earlier a couple of DJ's will play us some music, a food vendor to keep us fed and local amenities to make our stay comfortable.

Any vendor wishing to set up a table or auto jumble table please speak to Griff or Clive as the land owner may charge a fee. We will have a limited stock of Vanditos swag for sale over the weekend. We will also be offering some homebrew ale and cider for you to try.
